Baptism Reflection Form

The sacrament of Baptism is the first step of our faith journey. It is probably one of the most important steps of that journey. In the sacrament of Baptism, the Church welcomes children and adults into the community of faith

The gift of faith comes to you from God through the church and the community of believers-your family and parish family. The gift of faith must be accepted if it is to be truly a gift for you. At baptism, your parents and godparents accepted this gift in your name. They promised to nurture you in faith and help you to understand this gift by their lived example, so that one day you would be able to accept it yourself.

- ① Take a few minutes, sit down with your parents and talk about your Baptism. Ask your parents to tell you about the day you were baptized. Why did they pick your sponsors? What were their hopes and dreams for you in faith?
- ② Ask your parents why they chose the name they gave you. Was it in honor of a family member or of a favorite saint? What was it about you that they felt the name fit?
- ③ Take the time to fill in the Information about your Baptism. Then, after taking time to reflect on what they told you about their hopes for you, write a brief reflection on the back of this form.
