With school in session for a couple of weeks, we have reached the first three-day weekend on the elementary and high school calendar – Columbus Day, in which we recall an Italian who sailed under the Spanish flag and reached New World as it was called in the fifteenth century. The mariner never made it to the shores of what would become the United States, but he got very close. Since he made his discovery, he has been ever associated with America.

Religious Education Awards: Annually, the Diocese of Rockville Centre recognizes men and women who have volunteered to be catechists in their parishes and have participated in the Church's work of evangelization and education for their commitment over the years. The recognition for Saint Margaret parishioners comes on Sunday, October 16th at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Patchogue. For all of our catechists, we give thanks for their service. Without them, we would not have a Religious Education program and the Catholic faith would not get passed along outside the home. Hospitality: Last week, I asked the women of the parish to consider serving at receptions when we hold parish events in the church. The two events I have in mind are **Lessons and Carols** (December 18th) and **First Holy Communion** (May 13th). If you are interested, please call the parish office and let us know. The receptions would not be lengthy affairs and everything you need will be made available for you.

Bible Study: A staple of parish life in many places has been a group (both men and women) who have come together around the Scriptures. Getting to know the Scriptures better and getting to know fellow parishioners is the goal. Again, if you are so inclined, please call the parish center and register your interest. We will see if there are other parishioners who long to know the Scriptures better and see if we are able to launch a group for this purpose.

Mass Intentions: The Mass Book for 2023 opens on Monday, October 24th at 9:00 AM at the parish center. There are **no limitations on the number of Masses you may reserve at that time.**

Enrichment Evenings: We have two remaining sessions on Monday nights this month (the 17th and 24th). All are invited to join us at 7:30 PM. Sessions are over at 9:00 PM. We will treat **morality** on the 17th and the **sacraments** on the 24th. All catechists are asked to give consideration to attending – the sessions are intended primarily for you in your apostolate!

Eucharistic Revival: I am looking to see if we can arrange a retreat around the theme of the **Eucharistic Revival** for the Spring of 2023. I will keep you apprised of what may develop on this topic since there is such a great need for it now.

Twenty Minutes with the Director/Pastor: We have been at this catechetical initiative for a few weeks now. We ask our parents to attend with their children on the designated Sunday. We have arranged the schedule according to **level**. As always, we ask all parents of children enrolled in our Faith Formation program to go to Mass with their children **every week**. This is a precept of our Catholic faith and we should not take it lightly. Coming to know and love the Eucharist is inseparable from coming to know and love Jesus. There is no such thing as a Catholic faith apart from faithful participation in the Holy Eucharist each week and on Holy Days of Obligation.
