With school in session for a couple of weeks, we have reached the first three-day weekend on the elementary and high school calendar – Columbus Day, in which we recall an Italian who sailed under the Spanish flag and reached and New World as it was called in the fifteenth century. The mariner never made it to the shores of what would become the United States, but he got very close. Since he made his discovery, he has been ever associated with America.

**Enrichment Evenings:** We have two remaining sessions on Monday nights this month (the 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>). All are invited to join us at 7:30 PM. Sessions are over at 9:00 PM. We will treat **morality** on the 17<sup>th</sup> and the **sacraments** on the 24<sup>th</sup>. All cate-chists are asked to give consideration to attending – the sessions are intended primarily for you in your apostolate!

**Eucharistic Revival:** I am looking to see if we can arrange a retreat around the theme of the **Eucharistic Revival** for the Spring of 2023. I will keep you apprised of what may develop on this topic since there is such a great need for it now.

**Twenty Minutes with the Director/Pastor:** We have been at this catechetical initiative for a few weeks now. We ask our parents to attend with their children on the designated Sunday. We have arranged the schedule according to **level**. As always, we ask all parents of children enrolled in our Faith Formation program to go to Mass with their children **every week**. This is a precept of our Catholic faith and we should not take it lightly. Coming to know and love the Eucharist is inseparable from coming to know and love Jesus. There is no such thing as a Catholic faith apart from faithful participation in the Holy Eucharist each week and on Holy Days of Obligation.
